FORMED in 1999 as an experiment in 'post-Industrial house', the US electronica collective 3kStatic long ago staked its claim at the forefront of the deep alternative scene, fusing the post-punk angst of the earliest industrial music movement with modern 'dance music' sensibilities.

Now, on the heels of the success of the 2006 release *Where's Our Piece of the Groovy World?*, (itself a candidate for GRAMMY® award nomination in the Best Electronic/Dance Album category), comes *Voodoo Science* - an equally ambitious CD and 22-track digital double album - that also features a surprising array of guest artists and collaborators.

A sprawling selection of genre-bending tracks that pay tribute to the band's progressive music influences, *Voodoo Science* deftly weaves a soundtrack to both the creative process of enjoining disparate stylistic elements with a strident message of social and personal insurgency. The result is an album that cleanly whisks away the constrictions of genre and turns the 'usual' back on itself.
